Bluegrass Stomp! addresses both Music and Social Studies—NC Essential Standards—for all grade levels in three different programs. Age groups may be combined, if necessary.

- Pre-K through grade 2: Children clap and sing along with the oral traditions of the south. Songs include "Old Joe Clark," "Mole in the Ground," "Lollipop Tree," "Cripple Creek," and many more.
- Grades 3-5: Children enjoy clapping & calling and responding to the history of our state. Songs include "Follow the Drinking Gourd," "Chicken Train," "New River Train," Irish jigs, blues, and more.
- Grades 6-12: US history comes alive with a tapestry of music from the 1800's, including the Civil War era, with a view to how these musical forms laid the foundation for jazz, rock & roll, and hip-hop.
